INTRODUCTION

Isopods are one of the most morphologically diverse groups among the crustaceans. Probably because of their smallness in size (as in most of the cases) and cryptic behaviour they have remained unnoticed to most of the workers. They are predominantly marine but estuarine and freshwater forms are also well-represented. A large number of this group is also terrestrial. They may be free-living, parasitic, predators, filter predators, scavengers, wood-boring, myrmecophilous or cavernicolous. Corresponding to their diverse mode of life, their shape and size also varies markedly. The size of the isopods ranges from 300 micrometers (Microcerberidae) to about 50 cm as in the genus *Bathynomus* (Cirolanidae). The order Isopoda comprises of nine suborders of which, eight suborders namely, Asellota, Cymothoidea, Limnoria, Microcerberidea, Oniscidea, Phreatoicoidea, Sphaeromatoidea and Valvifera occur in India. The number of species belonging to these orders has been estimated to about 11,000.

Information on isopod fauna of India is very scattered. However, a perusal of literature reveals a total of 299 isopod species recorded from different parts of India (Dev Roy and Nandi, in press; Dev Roy, in press). This is about 2.7% of the total global isopod fauna. They belong to 131 genera and 38 families (Table 1). Among them, maximum number of species has been encountered in the family Bopyridae (52 species) followed by Cymothoidea (50 species) and Armadillidae (24 species).
